Qualifications for office are: be a member in good standing of C263 local; be a member for one year of an AFGE local immediately preceding the closing of the nomination process and may not be a member in any labor organization not affiliated with the AFL-CIO.

Candidates shall not run for more than one office in the same local election. Any member who has signed a dues withholding form (SF 1187) accepted by a responsible officer of the local is in good standing and eligible to nominate candidates.

A second for nomination is not required. Self-nominations are permissible. Nominations also may be made in writing.

Nomination/Acceptances will be accepted at the meeting only. It is the responsibility of the nominee or delegate proxy to ensure this is done. Monday, June 20, 2022 at the convention meeting room listed above. A lone letter of acceptance is a self-nomination.

Placement on the ballot will be determined by alphabetical order at the close of nominations.

The term of office will run for three (3) years ending with the installation of officers following the regularly scheduled elections in August 2025.

Each candidate may have a reasonable number of observers who are members, present throughout the election process, including the tally of ballots.
